

Section 2. Any person or persons, association, corporation, or company, who shall violate or cause to be violated, any of the provisions of this Article, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than twenty-five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars, and stand committed until the same is paid.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days from and after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 105

Introduced by E. N. Stoughton, 8/2-1915

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULT AND VALIDITY OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN AND FOR THE CITY OF POLSON, OF THE COUNTY OF FLATHEAD, STATE OF MONTANA, ON TUESDAY, TO WIT: THE TWENTIETH DAY OF JULY A. D. 1915, BETWEEN THE HOURS OF EIGHT O'CLOCK A. M. AND SIX O'CLOCK P. M. PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE ADVERTISEMENT AND SALE OF TWENTY-SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS WATER BONDS OF, BY AND FOR THE SAID CITY -- AUTHORIZED BY THE DULY QUALIFIED ELECTORS THEREOF AT SAID ELECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS in accordance with Ordinance No. 98 of the City of Polson, of the County of Flathead, State of Montana, passed and approved June 14th A. D. 1915, a special bond election was called and ordered to be held in and for said City on tuesday, to-wit; the 20th day of July, A. D. 1915, between the hours of eight o'clock A. M. and six o'clock P.M. for the purpose of voting upon the following question:

Shall the indebtedness of the City of Polson, Montana be increased over and above the three per cent limit fixed by law, by the issuance of water bonds to the amount of Twenty-six Thou and (\$26,000.00) Dollars to be used for the purpose of procuring and constructing a water system for said city which water system said city shall own and control and devote the revenue derived therefrom to the payment of the debt incurred therefor?

AND WHEREAS the City Clerk has caused due and sufficient evidence of the lawful publication of said ordinance, and notice of election appearing therein, and the proper posting of said notice, and the proper posting and publishing of the notice of registration by the City Clerk, to be furnished to this Council, and the said council has heretofore caused same to be filed of record as a part of the proceedings of said city; and

WHEREAS, After due canvass of the returns of said election as made by the said council acting as a board of canvassers, it was found, declared, certified and published that the total number of votes cast at said election submitted thereat, was ninety-two, of which eighty-eight votes were "Bonds Yes" and four were Bonds No." and that there was a majority of eighty-four of all the votes cast at said election "Bonds Yes"; said votes having been cast in the respective precincts of the city as follows:

Now therefore, in consideration of the premises.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, as follows:

Section 1. That the special bond election held in and for said city, on Tuesday, to-wit: the 20th day of July A. D. 1915, beginning at the hour of eight o'clock A. M. and closing at the hour of six o'clock P. M. be and the same is hereby determined and declared to have been duly called, noticed, and held in strict compliance with law.

Section 2. That the result of said election has been duly certified and returns thereof duly made to and canvassed by said council and said canvass shows that the total number of votes cast at said election upon the following question:



was ninety-two, of which eighty-eight votes were "Bonds Yes" and four were "Bonds No." and that there was a majority of eighty-four of all the votes cast at said election "Bonds Yes"; said votes having been cast in the respective wards of the town as follows:

Section 3. That it be and is hereby certified, recited and warranted that at said election a majority of all of the duly qualified electors present and voting at said election voted in favor of the issuance of the bonds hereinabove mentioned; and that the council is hereby duly authorized and empowered to issue and sell the bonds of said city, of the character, to the amount and for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 4. That notice is hereby authorized, ordered and directed to be given and published as hereinafter provided that the council of said city will sell, at public auction, to the bidder offering the highest price therefor, said issue of bonds, as and in the manner provided by sections 3456 and 3457, revised codes of Montana, of 1907 which said notice shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE AND SELL \$26,000.00 WATER (six per cent) BONDS OF, AND FOR THE CITY OF POLSON, OF THE COUNTY OF FLATHEAD STATE OF MONTANA, AT PUBLIC AUCTION TO THE BIDDER OFFERING THE HIGHEST PRICE THEREFOR.

Pursuant to the authority of Ordinance No. 105 of the City of Polson, of the County of Flathead, State of Montana, passed and approved August 2nd, A. D. 1915, authorizing and directing the advertisement and sale of certain bonds of said city, namely:

Water bonds of the City of Polson, of the County of Flathead, State of Montana, to an amount aggregating the principal sum of \$26,000.00 comprised of twenty-six bonds numbered consecutively from one to twenty-six, both numbers inclusive, of the denomination of \$1,000.00 each, and all dated July 1st, A. D. 1915, absolutely due and payable July 1st, A. D. 1935, but redeemable at the option of the city as follows:

Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) of said bonds numbered from one to five, both numbers inclusive, on and after the first day of July, 1919; Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) of said bonds numbered from six to ten, both numbers inclusive, on and after the first day of July, 1923; Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) of said bonds numbered from eleven to fifteen, both numbers inclusive, on and after the first day of July, 1927; Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) of said bonds numbered from sixteen to twenty, both numbers inclusive, on and after the first day of July, 1931, and Six Thousand Dollars (\$6000.00) of said bonds, numbered from twenty-one to twenty-six, both numbers inclusive on and after the first day of July, 1934; bearing interest from their date until paid at the rate of six (6) per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the 1st days of January and July respectively, in each year, both principal and interest thereon payable at the office of the City Treasurer of the City of Polson, State of Montana, or at the option of the holder at the National Bank of Commerce, in the city and State of New York, U. S. A.

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the bonds aforesaid will, at the office of the undersigned clerk, in said city, on Monday, to-wit the 13th day of September, A. D. 1915, at the hour of 10 o'clock, A.M. at public auction, be sold to the bidder offering the highest price therefor.

At said public auction, the successful bidder will be required to deposit with the undersigned clerk, a certified check payable to his order in the sum of Two Thousand (\$2000.00) dollars which check shall be held by the city and forfeited to it should the purchaser fail to take up and pay for said bonds when presented to him.

(a) Said notice shall be and the same is hereby ordered published for a period of not less than four (4) weeks prior to the date set for the sale of said bonds in "The Flathead Courier" a weekly newspaper published, printed and of general circulation in said city, and also in the "Commercial And Financial Chronicle" a newspaper published in the City of New York, U. S. A.

(b) The City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized, ordered, and

directed to cause said notice to be published as hereinabove provided and to procure proof of such publication in the form of Publisher's Affidavits, in duplicate, one set of which he shall preserve as a part of the files and records of his office and the other set of which he shall furnish to the purchaser of said bonds.

(c) The City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized, ordered, and directed to give the Board of Land Commissioners of the State of Montana, at least thirty days' notice prior to the date of said sale a copy of said notice and advertisement thereof, also full and complete proof of the proceedings had with reference to the issuance of said bonds and proof of same as provided in Section 2199 of the Revised Codes of Montana of 1907.

Section 5. That on Monday, to-wit: the 13th day of September, A. D. 1915, at the hour of ten o'clock A. M. the said council will meet at the office of the City Clerk therein and shall consider the bids, if any, received for the bonds aforesaid and take action thereon, as the facts warrant and as by law authorized and provided.

Section 6. That in as much as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that the city have an adequate water system, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall, therefore, be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
