

ORDINANCE NO. 112

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, A RIGHT OF WAY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, AND OPERATION OF ITS FLATHEAD VALLEY BRANCH OF RAILROAD IN THE CITY OF POLSON.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Section 1. There is hereby granted to the Northern Pacific Railway Company for the construction, maintenance, and operation of its Flathead Valley Branch of railroad in the City of Polson, for the purpose of and as a right of way for said line of railroad that certain strip, piece, or parcel of land within said City of Polson, shown and delineated on the blue print map hereto attached and made a part hereof, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

" A strip of land 60 feet wide being 30 feet on each side of center line as now staked from the point of crossing of the east line of Polson townsite to a line drawn at right angles to said center line to a point 783 feet northwesterly from point of crossing, measured along said center line, and 30 feet wide, being 15 feet on each side of center line from said point, an additional distance of 137 feet to end of line. Said center line is more particularly described as follows:

Entering said townsite of Polson at a point 253.4 feet south of the northeast corner of the townsite, making an angle of 6 degrees 55 minutes with the east line of the townsite, extending on tangent in a northerly direction to a point 52.5 feet north of said point of entrance, thence on a 13 degree curve to the left a distance of 512.8 feet, thence on a tangent an additional distance of 354.7 feet to the end of the line."
