

ORDINANCE NO 113

AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE SANITARY SEWER AND DRAINAGE CONNECTIONS, PROHIBITING THE USE OF ANY CESS-POOL, WELL, SINK OR PRIVY AFTER NOVEMBER FIRST 1917, CREATING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

Section 1 - It shall be the duty of every owner of property within the City limits of the City of Polson, whose property abuts on any street or alley in which there is a main, lateral or district sewer, to connect all waste pipes and drains on said premises with said sewer before November 1st, 1917, and after said date it shall be unlawful for any person to have, use or permit to be used on his premises, or for any occupant of the said premises to use or permit to be used any cess-pool, well, sink or privy, and any such cess-pool, well, sink or privy existing after November 1st 1917 is hereby declared a nuisance and any person maintaining, permitting or using the same shall be deemed guilty of maintaining a nuisance and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not more than three hundred dollars; provided however that in special cases where sanitary conditions are deemed dangerous to the public health and safety, the City Council or Board of Health may require connections to be made at any time upon fifteen days written notice.

Section 2 - All acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3 - Whereas an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation, of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.

Passed by the City Council this 14th day of May 1917 and approved by the Mayor on the same date.
