

ORDINANCE NO. 12.

An Ordinance providing for the consolidation of offices Chief of Police and Street Commissioner.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson.

Section 1. The offices of Chief of Police and Street Commissioner shall be and the same are hereby consolidated, so as that the same person who shall be appointed as Chief of Police shall by virtue of such appointment be Street Commissioner.

Section 2. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. Whereas an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, peace and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.

ORDINANCE NO. 13.

An Ordinance providing for the consolidation of the offices of City Attorney and City Clerk and Fixing the compensation governing same.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson.

Section 1. The offices of the City Attorney and City Clerk shall be and the same are hereby consolidated, so as that the same person who shall be appointed City Attorney shall by virtue of such appointment be City Clerk.

Section 2. That the salary and compensation for the combined office of City Attorney and City Clerk shall be and the same is hereby fixed in the sum of three hundred dollars per year.
