

ORDINANCE NO. 120.

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE AND TO REGULATE THE WORKING OF PRISONERS ON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, AND ELSEWHERE IN THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

SECTION 1. That from and after the passage and approval of this Ordinance it shall be lawful to cause any and all persons committed to the City jail for a term or imprisonment to perform manual labor upon any street, alley or elsewhere in the City of Polson, Montana.


SECTION 2. That it shall be the duty of the police department to provide suitable and ample police protection and supervision for prisoners at all times during the performance of said labor and during the times that they are being taken to and from their place of confinement.

SECTION 3. That it shall be the duty of the Street Commissioner to designate and lay out the work for said prisoners, which shall be work of a public nature and beneficial to the City of Polson. Said labor shall be performed during the usual working hours of eight (8) hours per day.

SECTION 4. That it shall be unlawful for any person committed to the City jail to refuse to perform such labor as is herein provided and that each and every such person failing or refusing to perform such labors shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than three (\$3.00) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100.00) dollars or imprisoned in the City jail for a period not exceeding thirty days, or both such fine and imprisonment, provided also that such person so convicted as is provided herein, shall during said term of confinement be required to perform the labors as is in this ordinance provided.


