

ORDINANCE N.O 124.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 5 ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS FOUND AT LARGE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON AND PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING SAME. "

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Section 1 - That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 5 be changed to read as follows: - The poundmaster shall collect the sum of five dollars (\$5.00) for each animal impounded, and one dollar (\$1.00 for feeding such animal each day the same may be kept, and fifty cents (50¢) for each notice posted which sum must be paid by the owner of the animal before the same can be redeemed, and the amount when collected must be paid by the poundmaster into the City Treasury.

Section 2 - Whereas, an emergency exists, and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 3 - All Ordinances or parts of ordinances that conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the City Council of the City of Polson in Flathead County, State of Montana, at a regular meeting thereof held on Monday, the 7th day of June, A. D. 1915, at its council chambers at the City Hall of said City, passed a resolution of its intention and declaring its intention to create a special improvement to be known and designated in said resolution as "Special Sewer Improvement District No. 1" of the City of Polson, Montana, for the purpose of Constructing sewers along streets, and alleys as herein described:

Beginning at a point that is hereby and hereinafter designated as the Initial Point, which is the intersection of the center line of E and 1st Streets of the original Townsite of the City of Polson, Montana; thence in a northerly direction along the center line of 1st Streets, between Block 21 of the original Townsite of said City and the city limits of said City, 380 feet to the intersection of the center line of 1st and D. Streets; thence North, 0017' East, 660 feet to a point in the Flathead River, and again.

Beginning at the Initial Point, thence in a southerly direction along the center line of 1st Streets, between Block 22 of said original Townsite of the said city of Polson and Block 1 of Riverside addition to said City of Polson, 190 feet to a point on a line running through the center of the alley which divides Blocks 22 and 23 of the original Townsite of said City of Polson; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley 480 feet, to a point on a line running through the center of the alley which divides Blocks 22 and 23 of said Original Townsite of said City of Polson; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley to a point where the line running through the center of said alley intersects the center line of 2nd Street of said City; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley 340 feet to a point where the center line of said alley intersects the east boundary line of said Block 23, and again.

Beginning at the Initial Point, thence westerly along the center line of E Street of said City between Block 1 of said Riverside Addition to the City of Polson and the city limits of said City, 190 feet, to a point where a line running through the center of the alley which divides Blocks 1 and 7 of Riverside Addition to said City of Polson, intersects the center line of E street of said city; thence southerly in said Riverside Addition to said City along the center line of said Alley. 380 feet, to a point where a line running through the center of said alley intersects the center line of E. Street of said City; thence southerly along the center line of said alley, 340

Beginning at a point 190 feet in a northerly direction from said Initial Point along the center line of 1st Street in said city of Polson, which point is the intersection of said center line of said 1st street with a line running through the center of the alley which divides Block 21 of the said original townsite of said City of Polson; thence in an easterly direction along the center line of said alley 430 feet, to a point where the center line of said alley intersects the east boundary line of said block 21 of said original townsite of said City of Polson.

Said lots, pieces or parcels of land being benefitted and assessed in the construction of said sewer are as follows, to-wit:

All of lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 11, and 12 in Block No. 1 of the City of Polson.

Also all of lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 in Block 7 of the City of Polson.

Also all lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16 in Block 21 of the City of Polson.

Also all lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 2nd 16 in Block 22 of the City of Polson..

Also all lots numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 in Block 23 of the City of Polson..

And also lot No. 7 in Block 12 of the City of Polson. That the approximate cost of making said improvements are as follows, to-wit:

\$50.00 per lot of 50 feet in width by 140 feet in length in said district or the sum of \$3,450.00 for the entire district herein described.

That the time when and the place where the City Council of the City of Polson will hear and pass upon all protests that may or shall be made against said improvements or the creation of said improvement district is at the regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Polson, to be held on the 6th day of July A. D. 1915, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. of said day in the City Council Chambers of said City Hall, at which time and place as has been designated by the City Council of said city, such protests, if any, must be in writing and must be delivered to the City Council of said City within fifteen days after the date of the first publication of this notice.

For a more particular description of the boundaries of said Special Sewer Improvement District No. 1, together with Plans and Specifications, to be seen, reference is hereby made to the Resolution of said City Council of the City of Polson creating said improvement District by Resolution No. 10 on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City of Polson.
