

ORDINANCE NUMBER 125.

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 124 AND AMENDING SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 5 ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF DOMESTIC ANIMALS FOUND AT LARGE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON AND PROVIDING RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE SAME" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Section 1 - That Section 8 of Ordinance Number 5 be changed to read as follows: - The poundmaster shall collect for the first offence the sum of Two Dollars Fifty Cents (\$2.50) and for the second and each succeeding offence, the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each animal impounded, and one dollar for feeding each animal each day the same is kept; Fifty Cents (50¢) for each notice posted and One Dollar (\$1.00) for each notice published in the local newspaper. Said sum or sums must be paid by the owner of the animal or animals before the same can be redeemed, and the amount when collected must be paid by the poundmaster into the City Treasury.

Section 2 - Whereas, an emergency exists, and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 3 - All ordinances or parts of ordinances that conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
