

ORDINANCE NUMBER 126.

An Ordinance Making it unlawful to deliver lectures or speeches on any of the streets, alleys, sidewalks or public grounds of the City of Polson, without a written permit from the Mayor or City Council.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Section 1 - It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to deliver an address or lecture, or make a speech, or cause a crowd to gather for any of said purposes on any of the streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks or public grounds within the city of Polson without said persons or persons having first made written application to and obtained a written permit from the city council or mayor for the use of the street, avenue, alley, sidewalk or public ground so to do. Said application shall be in writing, signed by the applicant or his agent, and shall set forth his residence, his address, and state the name of the applicant and whereat on such street, avenue, alley, sidewalk or public-ground the applicant desires permission for said purpose, and the subject or subjects of the lecture or speech to be delivered. The City Council or Mayor respectively, may refuse to grant such permission whenever in its or his judgment it would be to the best interest of the public, or public welfare or public safety so to do.

Section 2 - Any one found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment, in the city jail not to exceed ninety days, or fined not to exceed three hundred dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3 - All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
