ORDINANCE NO 132

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF WARDS AND THEIR BOUNDARIES, CREATING AN EMERGENCY, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 221 OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

Section 1 - That the territory embraced within the corporate limits of the City of Polson, shall be and the same is hereby divided into three wards, bounded and described as hereinafter set forth.

Section 2 - That all territory within the corporate limits of the City of Polson which lies west of 4th street and north of F street shall embrace and compose Ward No. 1.

Section 3 - That all territory within the corporate limits of the City of Polson which lies east of 4th street and north of F street shall embrace and compose Ward No. 2.

Section 4 - That all territory within the corporate limits of the City of Polson which lies south of F street shall embrace and compose Ward No. 3.

Section 5 - Ordinance number 121 of the City of Polson approved November 5th, 1917, as well as all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6 - Whereas an emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation, peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on February 20th, 1919.



ORDINANCE NUMBER 133

Introduced by W.A.Gregg.

An ordinance providing for the holding of a special election upon the question of whether or not the indebtedness of the City of Polson, Montana, shall be increased over and above the three per cent limit fixed by law, by the issuance of water bonds to the amount of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars to be used for the purpose of enlarging, extending and constructing a water system for said city, which water system and extensions thereof, said city shall own and controll and devote the revenues derived therefrom to the payment of the debt incurred therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

Section 1 - That it is necessary and desirable and deemed for the best interests of the City of Polson, by the City Council, that said city enlarge, extend and construct a water system and that the city shall own and controll the same and devote the revenue derived therefrom to the payment of the indebtedness incurred therefore.

Section 2 - That a special election be held in the City of Polson, Montana, on the seventh day of April, 1919 for the purpose of ascertaining the will of the taxpayers to be affected thereby, and that authority may be given and power conferred upon the City Council of said city to increase the indebtedness of said city over and above the three per cent limit fixed by law by the issuance of water bonds of said city to the amount of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars for the purpose of enlarging, extending and constructing a water system for said city, which water system said city shall own and control and the revenues derived therefrom shall be devoted to the payment of the indebtedness incurred therefor.

Section 3 - That the time and place of holding said election shall be as follows: At the City of Polson, State of Montana on the 7th day of April, 1919 from 8 o'clock A.M. to 6 o'clock P.M. of said day, and that the places of voting at said election shall be as follows:

- 2nd Ward - City Hall, 4th Street, Block 18.
- 1st Ward - Red Cross Building, 3rd Street, Block 11.
- 3rd Ward - Catholic Assembly Building, 4th Street, Block 29.
