

ORDINANCE NO. 149

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE NUMBERING OF THE HOUSES AND BUSINESS PLACES OF THE CITY OF POLSON AND CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON:

SECTION I

NUMBERING HOUSES

Even ~~odd~~ numbers to be given to houses and business places on the east and north sides of all streets and ~~even~~ ^{odd} numbers on the west and south sides of all streets.

All houses fronting on public streets in the city of Polson shall be numbered in conformity with the following provisions:

First - On streets running northwardly and southwardly, except blocks 1, 2 and 3 of the Original Townsite, the numbering shall commence with 101 on the ~~east~~ ^{west} side of all streets and number 102 on the ~~west~~ ^{east} side of all streets where said streets intersect with "A" street, thence running south on said streets with consecutive numbers.

Thence commencing on the south side of "B" street with number 201 on the ~~east~~ ^{west} side of all streets and number 202 on the ~~west~~ ^{east} side of all streets.

Thence commencing on the south side of C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O and P streets with numbers 301, 401, 501, 601, 701, 801, 901, 1001, 1101, 1201, 1301, 1401, 1501 and 1601 on the east side of all streets and number 302, 402, 502, 602, 702, 802, 902, 1002, 1102, 1202, 1302, 1402, 1502 and 1602 on the west side of all streets, allowing 100 numbers to each block.

Blocks 1, 2 and 3 of the Original Townsite facing on 4th street East and 5th street east shall be numbered commencing at the intersection of said streets with Kootenai Avenue on the south side. Commencing with Number 1 on the east side of the streets and number 2 on the west side of the streets.

Second - Commencing on each street running east and west where it intersects with first street, on the east side, with number 101 on the ~~west~~ ^{south} side and number 102 on the ~~east~~ ^{north} side of each ~~block~~ ^{street}, thence running east with consecutive numbers, the odd on the ~~west~~ ^{north} and the even on the ~~east~~ ^{south} side, allowing ~~100~~ ^{50 spaces} to each block; and thus continuing such numbering as aforesaid with the number of hundreds corresponding with the number of street, to the eastern boundary of the platted portion of the city which shall be known and designated as - - street east as the number or letter of the street as the case may be.

Commencing on each street running east and west where it intersects with first street, on the west side, with number 101 on the ~~west~~ ^{south} side and number 102 on the ~~east~~ ^{north} side, thence running west allowing ~~100~~ ^{50 spaces} for each block as aforesaid, commencing with number of hundreds corresponding with the street for each block on the east side of each respective block, so numbering each block to the westerly limits of the platted portion of the city, which shall be known and designated as street west, as the number or name of the street, as the case may be.

Third - Where there is but one building situated on a corner lot facing the street, it shall be numbered from the street and all lots shall be numbered according to the recorded plat of the city of Polson on file and of record in the office of the County Clerk & Recorder in and for the County of Lake, State of Montana, allowing one number for each ~~twenty-five~~ (25) feet.

STREET COMMISSIONER TO DESIGNATE NUMBERS

Fourth - The street commissioner shall designate the numbers of all houses and business places in conforming with the preceding provisions and shall furnish the owner of each house, now or hereafter built, with its proper number as soon as completed. When any house is not correctly numbered, or not numbered at all, the Street Commissioner shall give such house its proper number and require the same to be put on such house in a conspicuous place next to the street at the expense of the owner.

PENALTY FOR REFUSING TO NUMBER

Fifth - In case any owner, occupant or agent after having been requested as aforesaid by the Street Commissioner shall refuse or neglect for ten days to number a house as required, or shall number or attempt to number such house otherwise than in conformity with this article, and upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$50.00, and when such fine is paid the Street Commissioner shall cause such house to be correctly numbered at the expense of the City of Polson.

STREET SIGNS - NAMES OF STREETS

Sixth - The Street Commissioner shall, at the expense of the City of Polson, cause good and substantial signs, bearing the names of the streets in the City of Polson, to be put up and maintained as follows, to-wit: Upon at least two of the corners at each crossing of the streets, such signs shall be so placed as to be in plain view of persons passing either way upon any of said streets; provided that where there are no houses at or near such crossing, or the streets are not opened up or graded, the said Street Commissioner may delay the putting up of such signs until such time as he may deem it necessary, or until he shall be directed to do so by the City Council of the City of Polson.

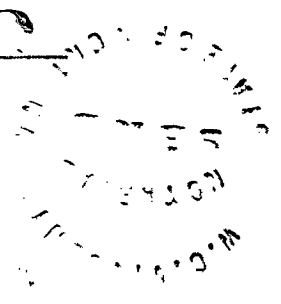
