

ORDINANCE NO. 159

An Ordinance designating certain streets of the City of Polson as Arterial Highways, and designating other streets as School Zones and providing for the Regulation of Traffic on the Streets, Alleys, Highways and Bridges of the City of Polson, and providing penalties for the violation of the provisions thereof and repealing paragraph "A" of Section 7 of Ordinance No. 115.

Section I

All that portion of 3rd street from the south line of "F" street to the north line of "B" street is hereby designated as an arterial highway and all that portion of "B" street from the west line of 3rd street to the east line of 5th street is hereby designated as an arterial highway. It shall be the duty of every person driving or operating a vehicle on any public street or highway of the city of Polson intersecting said portions of said 3rd and said "B" streets, herein designated as Arterial Highways, to yield the right of way to vehicles on said arterial highways and to bring the vehicle so driven or operated by him or her to a full stop before entering upon or crossing any part of said arterial highways when and where signs, posts or other markers so direct or indicate.

Section II.

Upon any street or highway of the city of Polson when and where signs, posts or markers so direct or indicate, it shall be the duty of every person driving or operating a vehicle over and upon said street or highway to bring the vehicle being operated by him or her to a full stop.

Section III.

No person driving or operating a vehicle upon said portions of 3rd street and "B" street so designated as arterial highways shall make a "U" turn when and where signs, posts or other markers so direct or indicate.

Section IV

All that portion of 5th street from the south line of "E" street to the north line of "D" street and all that portion of "D" street from the west line of 5th street, east for a distance of 680 feet is hereby designated as a "School Zone".

Section V.

No vehicle shall travel at a speed faster than twenty miles per hour on any street in the city of Polson, provided however, that the maximum speed limit shall not be greater than twelve miles per hour when passing school buildings or houses or upon any street or streets of the city of Polson designated as a School Zone, when and where signs, posts or other markers so direct or indicate. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit the officers, men, apparatus or vehicles of the fire department of the city of Polson from proceeding at such rate of speed as may be necessary for the proper discharge of their respective duties.

Section VI.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not exceeding ten days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section VII. :

Paragraph "A" of section seven of Ordinance No. 115 of the City of Polson and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section VIII.

Whereas an emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation, health and safety of the public, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval

ORDINANCE. No. 160

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION ONE (1) OF ORDINANCE No. 148 REGULATING SALARIES OF THE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana.

SECTION 1 That section One (1) of Ordinance No. 148 of the City of Polson, Montana is hereby amended so as to read as follows:- The compensation of the following officers of the City of Polson, Montana is hereby fixed and established at the following named salaries and that the same shall be accepted and taken as full compensation for all services rendered by said officers to the city.

Mayor-----\$150.00 per year.
Councilman:-----\$3.00 for each meeting, not to exceed two meetings a month.

Section 2. The said salaries shall be paid at the end of each month by the order of the city council and approval of the Mayor.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and posting according to law.
