

## ORDINANCE NO. 19.

An Ordinance providing for the establishment of Wards and their boundaries, and repealing Ordinance No.(7) Seven of the City of Polson, Montana.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson.

Section 1.- That the territory embraced within the corporate limits of the City of Polson, shall be and the same is hereby divided into three wards, bounded and described as herein-after set forth:

Section 2.- All that territory within the Corporate limits of the City of Polson which lies north of "C" Street and the tract known as the Power Plant Tract (which lies east of the original townsite of Polson), shall embrace and compose Ward Number One (1).

Section 3.- All that territory within the Corporate Limits of the City of Polson lying south of "C" Street and east of Third Street, shall be embraced in and compose Ward Number Two (2).

Section 4.- All that territory within the Corporate Limits of the City of Polson, lying south of "C" Street and west of Third Street (including Riverside Addition), shall be embraced in and compose Ward Number Three (3).

Section 5.- Ordinance Number Seven (7) of the City of Polson, approved July 22nd, 1910, as well as all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6.- Whereas as emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation, peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
