

ORDINANCE NO. 21.

An Ordinance to amend and revise Ordinance No. 14 of the City of Polson.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson.

Section 1.- That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 14 and the same is hereby amended in part as follows:-

The manager or lessee of every moving picture show or theatre must pay a license of \$7.50 per quarter.

Section 2.- That Section 28 of Ordinance No. 14 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

Every keeper of a rooming house shall pay a license as follows:-

Where the house has 10 rooms or less, \$1.50 per quarter.

Where the house has from 10 to 20 rooms, \$3.00 per quarter.

Where the house has 20 rooms or more, \$4.00 per quarter.

Section 3.- That Section 36 of Ordinance No. 14 be and the same is hereby amended as follows:-

Every building contractor must pay an annual license of \$25.00.

Architects and manufacturers shall pay a license of \$2.50 per quarter.


Section 4.- That Section 37 of Ordinance No. 14 be and the same is hereby amended as follows:-

Every keeper of a second-hand store shall pay a license of \$4.00 per quarter.

Section 5.- Every keeper of a milliner store shall pay a license of \$2.50 per quarter.

Section 6.- Every person or persons who at a fixed place of business carried on the business of general blacksmithing shall pay a license of \$2.50 per quarter.

Section 7.- Any person or persons, company or corporation transacting any business for which a license is required by this Ordinance without first procuring a license shall be deemed guilty of misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall pay a fine in any sum not exceeding three hundred dollars and may be sentenced to the City Jail and confined therein for a period not to exceed sixty days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court, and each day during which the business is conducted without a license shall be considered a separate offence and



punishable accordingly.

Section 8.- Whereas an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation, peace, health and public safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.

Section 9.- All Ordinances and parts thereof, so far as they may conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
