

RESOLUTION NO. 94

A resolution creating Special Sewer Improvement District Number Nine of the City of Polson, Montana, designating the boundaries thereof, as defined by resolution of intention Number 91, passed by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana, on the 11th day of June, 1948, and referring to said resolution of intention for further particulars.

Whereas, it appears to the satisfaction of the city council of the city of Polson, Montana, that notice of the passage of a resolution of intention to create special sewer improvement district No. 9 passed by the city council of the City of Polson, Montana, on the 11th day of June, 1948, has been published as required by law, and that copies of said notice has been mailed to all property owners within said proposed district as required by law, and proofs thereof being filed with the city clerk.

And, whereas, it further appears to the satisfaction of the city council that owners of less than 40 per cent of all the property affected and situated within said special sewer improvement district No. 9, and liable for an assessment thereof within the district have protested against the creation of said district in the manner prescribed by law. Fact is no protests have been made. That the general character of the proposed improvements to be made in said improvement district No. 9 is the acquiring, building, extending, and maintaining a sewer and sewer system.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the city council of the city of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. That the said Special Sewer Improvement District No. 9 be and the same is hereby created.

Section 2. That the property to be included therein is bounded and described as follows:

All of that property situated in the county of Lake, State of Montana, as follows: All of blocks 1 and 2 of central addition, and all of block 1, of Lewis addition, of and in said city of Polson, and that the boundaries are as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of lot 1, block 1, Central addition of and in the city of Polson, Montana, thence west to the Northwest corner of Lot 6, Block 1, South to the southwest corner of lot 7, block 1, Lewis addition of and in the city of Polson, Montana, thence east to the southeast corner of lot 12, block 1 of central addition of said city, thence north to the point of beginning.

And as fully described in resolution of intention, and reference for further particulars is hereby made to said resolution of intention.

Section 3. That the manner of paying for said improvements shall be as described in said resolution of intention No. 91, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars.

ORDINANCE No. 219

An ordinance providing a method of doing work and improvements upon the city streets of the city of Polson, Montana, to prepare said streets (including avenues) within Sprinkling District No. 14C so that oil sprinkled thereon may be of durable and continuing benefits, paying for the same, creating an emergency, repealing ordinances in conflict, providing effective date.

Be it ordained by the town council of the city of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. That all of the streets, including avenues, included within oil sprinkling district No. 14C in the City of Polson, Montana, shall be prepared and improved so that oil sprinkling shall be of a durable and continuing benefit.

Section 2. That the costs of such improvements shall be assessed against all of the property within said oil improvement district, area basis; work to be done by the City employees.

Section 3. Whereas an emergency exists, and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public that this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 4. All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

RESOLUTION NO. 95

A resolution fixing the total amount of bonds to be issued for special Sewer District No. 9 in Polson, Montana, and authorizing the sale of same and giving of notice of sale of bonds, declaring an emergency.

Be it resolved by the city council of the city of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. That total amount of bonds to be issued for making improvements in special Sewer District No. 9 of Polson, Montana, is in the amount of \$6,000, payable over a period of ten years.

Section 2. That the clerk is directed to give notice of the sale of the same in the manner as required by law.

Section 3. That the issuance of said bonds in said amount is hereby authorized.

Section 4. An emergency exists and by reason thereof this resolution becomes effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

Section 5. All resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

RESOLUTION NO. 96

A resolution creating special Sewer District No. 9 fund in, and for the city of Polson, Montana, and providing for the payment of all claims duly sworn to and filed with the Clerk, and approved by the City Council covering all amounts, and the amounts expended, and to be expended in making said improvements, authorizing the Clerk to issue and sell warrants and providing for the payment of the same.

Be it resolved by the city council of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. That there be, and is hereby created in the city of Polson, Montana, a special Sewer Improvement District No. 9 fund, and all special taxes paid upon all of the property situated in said district shall be paid into said fund.

Section 2. The Clerk and Treasurer are authorized to pay all legal claims filed against said fund, when the claims are approved and when said bonds of said district have been sold and funds are available, and payments to be made in the manner provided for by law.

Section 3. It is the opinion of the city council that an emergency exists requiring that this ordinance take effect immediately, and be in force after its adoption and approval, and by reason thereof this ordinance takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
