Ordinance No. 221

Ordinance providing for the payment of the bonds of Special Improvement Sewer District No. 9, of the City of Polson, in Lake County, Montana, together with interest thereon, and the levy of an annual tax sufficient to pay the interest thereon and redeem one-tenth each year, beginning with the year 1949.

Be it ordained by the city council of the City of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. That the city council of the City of Polson, Montana, having heretofore created special Sewer District No. 9 for the construction of certain improvements in said district, that all costs and expenses of such improvements shall be paid by special improvement bonds with coupons attached and that the payment of said bonds and interest should be evidenced by a special tax sufficient to pay the same in 10 installments from date of issue. That it is the intention of said council to redeem one-tenth of the bonds in the year 1949, and a like amount each year thereafter until the whole amount is paid. And it is necessary that an annual tax be levied upon all of the taxable property in said district for the payment of said bonds and interest, together with said one-tenth of the bonds, said bonds extending over a period of ten years.

Section 2. That the city of Polson redeem, one-tenth of the Special Sewer District No. 9 bonds each year for the years 1949, 1950, 1951, 1952, 1953, 1954, 1955, 1956, 1957, and 1958, inclusive, than an annual tax be levied and collected as provided for by law upon all the taxable real estate in said special improvement district sufficient to pay all amounts upon said bonds, and to create a sinking fund for their redemption; that the taxes so levied and collected shall be so used, and for no other purpose, and paid according to order beginning with No. 1.

Section 3. That the amount of bonds to be issued is in the amount of \$6,000.

Ordinance No. 222

An ordinance naming and renaming the streets and avenues of the City of Polson, Montana, fixing effective date, and repealing all ordinances in conflict therewith.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana.

Section 1. That all streets running east and west be re-named avenues with the following avenue names:

- First Avenue to replace A Street
- Second Avenue to replace B Street
- Third Avenue to replace C Street
- Fourth Avenue to replace D. Street
- Fifth Avenue to replace E Street
- Sixth Avenue to replace F Street
- Seventh Avenue to replace G Street
- Eighth Avenue to replace H Street
- Ninth Avenue to replace I and Lake Streets
- Tenth Avenue to replace J and High Streets
- Eleventh Avenue to replace K Street and First Avenue

Twelfth Avenue to replace L Street and Second Avenue
 Thirteenth Avenue to replace M. Street and Third Avenue
 Fourteenth Avenue to replace N Street and Fourth Avenue
 Fifteenth Avenue to replace Fifth Avenue
 Sixteenth Avenue to replace Sixth Avenue

That all streets running north and south be renamed with the following street names:

Main Street to replace Third Street
 First Street East to replace Fourth Street
 Second Street East to replace Fifth Street and Lincoln Avenue
 Third Street East to replace Garfield Avenue
 Fourth Street East to replace McKinley Avenue
 Fifth Street East to replace First Street and Seventh Street
 Sixth Street East to replace Second and eighth Streets
 Seventh Street East to replace Third and Ninth Streets
 Eighth Street east to replace Fourth Street and Tenth Street
 Ninth Street East to replace Fifth Street
 First Street West of Main Street to replace Second Street
 Second Street West to replace First Street
 Third Street West to replace Hawthorne Avenue
 Fourth Street West to replace Maple Avenue
 Fifth Street West to replace Cedar Avenue
 Eighth Street West to replace Birch Avenue

Section 2 . All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance to become effect 30 days after passage and approval.

Resolution No. 98

A resolution authorizing the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana to sell certain described real estate within the corporate limits of the City of Polson: reciting and declaring said property not held in trust for a specific purpose, nor in use or needed by said City, fixing the sale price, authorizing the execution of proper conveyances, repealing all resolutions in conflict, fixing effective date of the resolution.

Whereas the City of Polson is now the owner of that real estate and those premises hereinafter described, situated within the corporate limits of said city,

Whereas said property is not held for specific use nor specific trust, and the city is not using the same nor will it have any use in the future for the same,

Whereas said property is without any value, nor can it ever be sold for any value because of its location and topography, and whereas no one else other than the named purchaser herein will purchase same,

Whereas it would be to the best advantage of the city and its inhabitants if said property be sold as provided for herein as the said property will be placed on the tax rolls and improved and afford an industry for the city,

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the city council acting in behalf of the city sell to Polson Lumber Company of Polson, Montana, a corporation, for the sum of ten dollars, those premises situated in the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, particularly described as follows, to-wit: A tract of land designated as Public reserve No. ___ situated in the extreme Northeast corner of the Original Townsite of Polson and lying East of Fifth Street in said city, and adjacent to the present property and site of the Polson Lumber Company.

Be it resolved that the Mayor and Clerk are directed to execute proper conveyance, to said purchaser, with complete and corrected description.

Be it further resolved that said resolution becomes effective 30 days after its passage and approval.
