

ORDINANCE NO 29.

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE MANNER IN WHICH ORDINANCES SHALL BE PASSED AND PUBLISHED, AND THE EFFECT OF REPEALING AN ORDINANCE OR A PART OF AN ORDINANCE.

BE it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION I. The Style of the Ordinances of the City of Polson shall be: "Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson", and all ordinances shall be signed by the Mayor or presiding officer of the Council, and by the City Clerk; and shall be published within 15 days after their passage, by the City Clerk by posting a copy of each ordinance in three of the most public places in the City of Polson, and due proof of such posting by the affidavit of the City Clerk shall be made by the Clerk and attached thereto, or written and attested upon the face of the record of such Ordinance by the Clerk.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances passed by the City Council shall be numbered in the order of their passage, provided that a mere omission to comply with this section shall not invalidate any ordinance.

SECTION 3. Whenever an Ordinance or part of an Ordinance shall be repealed or modified by a subsequent Ordinance, the ordinance or part of the ordinance thus repealed or modified, shall continue in force until the repealing ordinance shall go into effect, or until such time as may be specially designated in said repealin Ordinance.
