ORDINANCE NO. 4.

Providing for a seal for the City of Polson.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson.

SECTION. I.

A seal in a circular form with the words, "THE CITY OF POLSON MONTANA," on the outer circle, and in the interior and center of the said circle, the words, "CORPORATE SEAL," shall be the seal of the City of Polson, to be used in all cases in which, by the laws and customs of nations, it is necessary to use a seal by a corporation.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval and publication according to law.
