

ORDINANCE NO. 40.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LEAVING HORSES UNHITCHED OR PASSING THROUGH THE CITY WITHOUT SUITABLE HARNESS.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. No person, within the limits of the City of Polson shall leave standing, unfastened, or without being securely fastened, (without some suitable person of proper age and discretion in full control of the same), any horse, or other animals, single or in team, in harness, attached to a wagon, sleigh or other vehicle, nor shall any person allow any of the same to pass through or be in any of the streets, of the City without a suitable harness and driver, or person in charge of the same. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding fifty dollars.

SECTION 2. Whereas, an emergency exists, and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.
