

ORDINANCE NO. 45.

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL, WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE MAYOR, TO BUILD BONFIRES, HAVE TORCH LIGHT PROCESSIONS, DISCHARGE ANVILS OR FIREARMS, OR SET OFF FIRECRACKERS, ROCKETS, OR OTHER FIREWORKS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to build bonfires in any street, alley, square or vacant lot in any part of the city, within the fire limits of the City of Polson, without the written permission of the Mayor, nor without like permit for any torchlight procession to parade the streets of the city; or for any person to discharge any pistol, gun, anvil or firearms, or to set off firecrackers, rockets, or other fireworks, without permission from the Mayor.

Any violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a misdemeanor and be punishable by a fine in any sum not exceeding fifty dollars.

SECTION 2. Whereas, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
