

ORDINANCE NO. 47.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING STREET EXHIBITIONS, GAMES OF CHANCE, IN CERTAIN PLACES IN THE CITY, AND AFFIXING PENALTY THEREFOR.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION I. Whoever shall, upon any street, sidewalk, alley or public square within this city conduct or carry on, or assist in conducting or carrying on, any street exhibition, or any prize or lottery game, or game of chance, or game of fortune, or exhibition, or game of any description whatever, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than twenty nor more than one hundred dollars.

SECTION 2. Whereas, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.


