

ORDINANCE NO. 52.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE MALICIOUS INJURY OR DESTRUCTION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Malicious destruction of property forbidden. Any person who shall wilfully, unlawfully and maliciously destroy, burn, cut or otherwise injure or destroy any goods, chattels, or other property of any description whatever, the property of another, within the limits of the City of Polson, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars.
