

ORDINANCE NO. 55.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING EXPECTORATING UPON CERTAIN PLACES WITHIN THE CITY OF POLSON; AND AFFIXING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Expectorating and penalty. If any person shall hereafter expectorate upon any sidewalk, hallway of any office or public building, floor of public conveyance or street car, or stairway of any public office or office building, in the City of Polson, he shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof be fined in a sum not less than one dollar nor more than fifty dollars.
