

ORDINANCE NO. 56.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HAVING IN ONE'S POSSESSION UNLAWFULLY ANY BURGLER'S TOOLS, OR APPLIANCES, AND AFFIXING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Possession Any person having in his possession any nippers of burgler's of the description known as burgler's nippers, tools unlawful. pick-lock, skeleton key, key to be used with a bit or bits, jimmy, or other burgler's instruments or tools of whatsoever kind or description, unless such possession is innocent or for a lawful purpose, shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this Ordinance, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars.
