ORDINANCE NO. 58.

AN ORDINANCE TO PUNISH FRAUDULENT DEVICES AND PRACTICES.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Fraudulent schemes and devices prohibited. Any person who engages in or aids in any game, device, trick or scheme designed or intended to cheat, swindle or defraud any one out of money or property, or who shall attempt or aid in attempting to cheat or defraud any one of any money or property by any game, trick, scheme, or device used in any game of chance, sleight-of-hand, trick or scheme calculated or intended to cheat, swindle or defraud any one out of any money or property, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof be fined in a sum not exceeding two hundred dollars.
