

ORDINANCE NO. 64.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OBSTRUCTION OF LOBBIES, AISLES, AND PASSAGEWAYS IN THEATERS, HALLS OR PUBLIC PLACES WHEN IN USE BY THE PUBLIC.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Aisles and lobbies must not be obstructed. No chairs, stools, or seats of any description shall be placed or permitted to remain in or across the lobby, aisle or passageways in any theater, hall or public place, when the same is occupied by the public, under a penalty of one hundred dollars for each and every violation of this section.
