

ORDINANCE NO. 65.

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING OWNER OR LESSEE OF LICENSED THEATERS, HALLS OR OTHER BUILDINGS, TO KEEP THEM FREE FROM DANGER BY FIRE BY HIRING PERSONS FOR THAT PURPOSE.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Duty of owners and lessee of theaters and halls. It shall be the duty of every owner or lessee of every licensed theater, hall or other building, to keep and preserve the same from danger by fire while occupied by the public, and to that end he shall hire and keep at his own expense a sufficient number of persons for that purpose.
