

ORDINANCE NO. 67.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LEASING OF BUILDINGS NOT IN THE CONDITION OF CLEANLINESS AND WHOLESOMENESS REQUIRED BY LAW OR ANY CITY ORDINANCE.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Cleanliness No owner, agent or lessee of any building or any of buildings part thereof, shall lease or let or hire out the required. same or any portion thereof, to be occupied by any person or allow the same to be occupied by any person, or allow the same to be occupied as a place in which any one may dwell or lodge, except when said buildings or such parts thereof are sufficiently lighted, ventilated, provided and accomidated, and in all respects in that condition of cleanliness and wholesomeness for which this ordinance or any law of this s state provides, or in which they or either of them require any such premises to be kept.
