

ORDINANCE NO. 68.

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND LICENSE VENDOR OF MEDICINES, DRUGS AND NOSTRUMS.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Sale of medicines and drugs regulated. SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, company, corporation, or aggregation of people for the purpose of advertiseing, selling or giving away any drug, medicine, nostrum or any other substance for the cure of or pretended cure of any diseases or ailments, to give any public exhibition in any hall or building or tent or upon any streets or alleys or vacant lots or elsewhere, or in any place in the city of Polson, whether the admission to said performance and exhibition be free or not; and for any person, persons, company, corporation, or aggregation of people by proclamation, public outcry, auction or theatrical performance or show of any kind in any hall, or building, or tent, or upon any street, or alley, or vacant lot or elsewhere or at any place in the City of Polson, to sell, batter or give away any drug, medicine or any other substance for the cure of or pretended cure of any disease or ailment until such person, persons, company, corporation or aggregation of people shall have first procured a City license therefor, and for such license there shall be paid the sum of fifty dollars for each day or part of a day.

Penalty: SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this ordinance, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than fifty dollars nor more than three hundred dollars.

When in effect. SECTION 3. Whereas, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety, of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
