ORDINANCE NO. 70.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ADVERTISEMENT OF NOSTRUMS OR TREATMENT OF DISEASE.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Use of nostrums and treatment of diseases by same prohibited.	No person shall place or post, or cause to be placed or posted in any street or other public place in the City of Polson, any handbill or advertisement giving notice of any person having or professing to have skill in the treatment or curing of any disorder or disease, or giving notice of the sale or exposure to sale of any nostrum.
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Penalty.	Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, together with costs.

ORDINANCE NO. 71.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SALE OF POISONS.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Sale of poisons provisionally prohibited.

No person shall vend, give or deliver, within the limits of this city, any deadly poison, knowing the same to be such, without marking the bottle, vial, box or package containing the same, in legible characters, "POISON,"

Penalty.

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, and costs of suit.
