

ORDINANCE NO. 75.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PERSONATION OF OFFICERS.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

Personation of officers forbidden. No person shall personate a policeman or other officer of the city by wearing a star, badge, uniform or other insignia of officer, or use a police whistle similar to that adpoted by regular policemen.
