

ORDINANCE NO. 76.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF POLSON, WHEREIN THE PENALTY IS NOT PRESCRIBED, FOR THE JUDGEMENT UPON CONVICTIONS FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY ORDINANCE, AND COSTS.

Be it Ordained, by the Council of the City of Polson:

SEC. I. Any person or persons, violating any of the provisions of the ordinances of this city, wherein the penalty is not prescribed, shall, upon conviction thereof be fined in any sum not less than twenty five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars, and shall be committed to jail until such fine be satisfied, in the proportion of one day's imprisonment for every two dollars of the fine, and be adjudged to pay the costs of such prosecution.

SEC. 2. Whereas, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.


