

ORDINANCE NO. 78.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LEAVING ANIMALS ATTACHED TO WAGONS UNHITCHED, AND AFFIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it Ordained by the Council, of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. Leaving horses or other animals unhitched on streets prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person to leave any horse or other animal attached to a wagon or other vehicle, standing in any street or alley in this city without securely hitching such animal to a post or some secure object which is unconnected with the wagon or vehicle to which such animal is attached. Provided, that no single animal shall be hitched to a weight of less than 20 lbs. and no team of more than one animal to a weight of less than 40 lbs., and that the hitching strap shall be attached to the bit of the bridle of the animal.

SECTION 2. Penalty. Any person violating this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than one (\$1.00) dollar, and not more than twenty (\$25.00) five dollars.

An emergency existing in the opinion of the Council, this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
