



ORDINANCE NO. 80

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND SEWER WARRANTS AND PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY CLERK AND CITY TREASURER IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. It shall be the duty of the City Council to annually levy an assessment and tax for the payment of the principal and interest of all Special Improvement District and Sewer Warrants which may be issued by order of the City Council on and after the passage and approval of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. Whenever a Special Improvement or Sewer District is created by the City of Polson for the purpose of constructing sewers, improving the streets, alleys and highways of said District, or opening, changing or altering any streets, alleys and highways within the limits of said district, it shall be the duty of the City Clerk to open an account against the said improvement or sewer district so created, and said account shall be kept in a book provided for the purpose, and in such account, said City Clerk shall charge all cost and expense connected therewith, as prescribed in the resolution and ordinance creating said district, and the City Clerk shall issue by direction of the City Council Special Improvement District or Sewer Warrants of the kind and character described in the ordinance relating to the form thereof, and charging such account with said warrants. And the book of record shall state the date of such improvement or sewer district, to whom issued and the amount thereof, to the end that the cost of and the purpose for which said improvement district is created, shall at all times be a matter of public record; and when such warrants shall have been redeemed and paid by the City Treasurer, as hereinafter provided, the respective accounts of said Special Improvement or Sewer Districts, shall be properly credited with warrants so redeemed.

SECTION 3. Whenever a Special Improvement District or Sewer Warrant shall have been issued by the City of Polson and said warrant shall bear upon its face the regularity of issuance, as prescribed in the ordinance relating thereto, it shall be presented to the City Treasurer for payment, and if there are no funds to the credit of the said Special Improvement or Sewer District and sufficient to pay said warrant, it shall be the duty of the City Treasurer to register said Special Improvement or Sewer Warrant in a book to be provided for the purpose, and said registry shall set forth the number of the said Special Improvement or Sewer District, the date of registration of said warrant, the amount of such warrant and the person or persons to whom said warrant is issued, and the City Treasurer shall endorse upon the face of said warrant the date of registration of said warrant, and shall affix his signature thereto.

SECTION 4. It shall be the duty of the City Treasurer to prepare a book of record which shall be known as the Register of Special Improvement District and Sewer Warrants, and whenever a special improvement or sewer district is created and designated by proper number, it shall be the duty of the City Treasurer to open in said book of registration, an account with such special improvement or sewer district, giving such account its proper number, and he shall enter in said book of registration a proper record of all special improvement or sewer warrants presented to him for registration or payment issued under their respective districts, as in the manner provided in section 2 of this ordinance. And it is further prescribed as the duty of the City Treasurer to credit each Special Improvement and Sewer District account from time to time as the same is paid, with all taxes and assessments which may be collected by him on account of special taxes or assessments levied against the respective special improvement and sewer districts, and he shall apply the fund so collected in the following manner, to-wit:

FIRST: From the moneys collected on account of any special improvement or sewer district, in each year, he shall provide for the payments of interest on or before the 1st day of January, in each year to that date, on any and all outstanding warrants of each respective special improvement and sewer district whereon interest has not ceased by reason of said warrants being called for payment, and shall endorse said payment of interest on the reverse side of each warrant with the interest so paid, or by taking up and cancelling the interest coupons representing such interest if any such coupons be attached to said warrants; the first payment of interest to be computed for the period from date of registration of each of said warrants to the 1st day of January next succeeding such date of registration and annually thereafter.

SECOND: Out of the remainder of any funds to the credit of such improvement or sewer districts, the City Treasurer shall then call in and pay warrants to the amount of such moneys on hand available for the purpose, so far as such funds will pay and retire the amount that may be due, with accrued interest, to date of call for redemption and payment, fixing by notice the date whereon the interest shall cease upon such warrant; and it shall be the duty of the City Treasurer to note upon such register the date of call, and to notify the holders of said warrants by letter, if known, or by publication in a paper of general circulation published in the City of Polson, the call for the redemption of said warrants and the date when interest on said warrants shall cease.

SECTION 5. It shall be the duty of the City Treasurer, at any time after the redemption and payment of any Special Improvement or Sewer Warrants, as hereinafter mentioned, to cancel and deliver the same to the City Clerk of the City of Polson, and take his receipt therefor, to the end that such warrants when paid and cancelled shall be properly filed, in the office of the City Clerk.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall govern and apply to all special Improvement district and sewer warrants issued and registered from and after the 5th day of April, 1912.

SECTION 7. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This ordinance, there being an emergency in the opinion of the Council for its immediate enforcement, is in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$, WHICH IS AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SYSTEM OF STREET GRADES IN THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION I. That SECTION 2 of Ordinance NO 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ be amended to read as follows:

FIRST STREET.

Change of grade on north line of "E Street"
 from 2917.00 to 2913.60
 Change of grade on south line of "E Street"
 from 2917.00 to 2913.60

HAWTHORNE AVENUE.

Change of grade on south side of "E Street"
 from 2917.90 to 2912.70
 Change of grade on north side of "E Street"
 from 2917.90 to 2912.70

MAPLE AVENUE.

Change of grade on South side of "E Street"
 from 2917.60 to 2911.80

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts thereof that may conflict therewith are hereby repealed.
