SECTION 1. That SECTION 2 of Ordinance NO 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ be amended to read as follows:

FIRST STREET.

Change of grade on north line of "E Street"
from 2917.00 to 2913.60
Change of grade on south line of "E Street"
from 2917.00 to 2913.60

HAWTHORNE AVENUE.

Change of grade on south side of "E Street"
from 2917.90 to 2912.70
Change of grade on north side of "E Street"
from 2917.90 to 2912.70

MAPLE AVENUE.

Change of grade on South side of "E Street"
from 2917.60 to 2911.80

SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts thereof that may conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 82.

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF WOODEN SIDEWALKS, DEFINING THE MATERIAL AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE SAME, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. That all wooden sidewalks within the City of Polson hereafter constructed shall be under the supervision of the City Engineer or Street Commissioner, and to the satisfaction of the City Council.

SECTION 2. That all sills shall be laid not more than two feet apart and where sills are clear of the ground there shall be blocking or posts not more than six feet apart under each sill. All sills and construction shall not be less than 1 3/4 of an inch thick and shall not be less than 6 inches wide. Blocks or posts must be sound and not less than 1 3/4 X 6 inches, or if square timber is used not less than 3 3/4 X 3 3/4, and all planks used in floor of walks shall be 2 X 6 inches and all material must be sound without any loose knots. All sidewalks shall be so constructed that no crack in the walk will exceed 3/4 of an inch in width and planks to be laid crossways of the street, the floor of all walks to be of sized lumber and nailed with two nails in each sill.

SECTION 3. Any person or persons violating this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not less than and penalty. five (\$5.00) dollars.

An emergency existing in the opinion of the Council, this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
