ORDINANCE NO. 82.

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF WOODEN SIDEWALKS, DEFINING THE MATERIAL AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE SAME, AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. That all wooden sidewalks within the City of Polson hereafter constructed shall be under the supervision of the City Engineer or Street Commissioner, and to the satisfaction of the City Council.

SECTION 2. That all sills shall be laid not more than two feet apart and where sills are clear of the ground there shall be blocking or posts not more than six feet apart under each sill. All sills and construction shall not be less than 1 3/4 of an inch thick and shall not be less than 6 inches wide. Blocks or posts must be sound and not less than 1 3/4 X 6 inches, or if square timber is used not less than 3 3/4 X 3 3/4, and all planks used in floor of walks shall be 2 X 6 inches and all material must be sound without any loose knots. All sidewalks shall be so constructed that no crack in the walk will exceed 3/4 of an inch in width and planks to be laid crossways of the street, the floor of all walks to be of sized lumber and nailed with two nails in each sill.

SECTION 3. Any person or persons violating this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not less than and penalty. five (\$5.00) dollars.

An emergency existing in the opinion of the Council, this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.

O R D I N A N C E N O. 83

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION, MANAGEMENT, IMPROVEMENT AND USE OF LAKE SHORE LANDS ABUTTING UPON THE STREETS, ALLEYS OR PARKS BELONGING TO THE CITY OF POLSON.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson.

SECTION 1. The lake shore lands lying between low water mark and high water mark and abutting upon the Lake shore streets, alleys or parks of the City of Polson land, under shall be under the supervision of the City Marshall supervision shall who shall regulate the public and private of Marshall use of the same in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. All such lands are hereby declared to be free and open to public use for access to and from To whom the waters of Flathead Lake, except where the use accessible of any portion of said land may be granted to any individual or corporation under the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Any person desiring to use any portion of said Lease, how land for the construction of docks, wharves, warehouses, or for other purposes shall file an application obtained. in writing with the City Council stating the amount of land desired, the location of the same, and the purpose for which the land is to be used.

SECTION 4. All applications for the privilege of using Applications such land shall be considered by the City Council at the first regular meeting after when considered the same have been filed, and where two or more applications are made for the same site, preference shall be given to the application which is first in point of time.

SECTION 5. Any person or corporation having improved any of Right of said land by the construction of buildings, docks, or wharves prior to the passage of this ordinance, pry or poss- shall be allowed thirty days from the final enactment. of this ordinance during which time said person or corporation shall have the exclusive right to apply for the use of such land so occupied.
