ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE APPOINTIVE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. The compensation of the City Clerk, City Treasurer, City Attorney, Police Judge, Health Officer, Street Salaries Commissioner, Chief of Police, Chief of the Fire Department, Policemen and Firemen is hereby fixed and established at the following named salaries: That the same shall be accepted and taken as full compensation for all services to be rendered by said officers for the City of Polson, Montana until changed by ordinance.

City Clerk, per annum -----	\$ 360.00
City Treasurer " " -----	100.00
Health Officer " " -----	100.00
Chief of Police and Street Comm- issioner per annum -----	720.00
Chief of Fire Dept, per call ---	2.00
Firemen, per call -----	1.00
Policemen, each per day -----	3.00

SECTION 2. The said several salaries shall be paid at the end of each month, by warrant, issued and drawn by order of the Mayor and City Council, according to law.
Salaries now paid

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

SECTION 4. All ordinances and parts thereof, so far as they may conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
