

O R D I N A N C E N O. 88.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE, WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, OF CHICKENS, DUCKS, GEESE, TURKEYS AND OTHER DOMESTIC FOWL AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson:

SECTION 1. No person or persons, within the limits of the City of Polson, permit any chickens, ducks geese, turkeys or other domestic fowl, belonging to such person or persons, to run at large upon the streets, alleys or public places or upon any vacant lot or lots unless the same are securely fenced.

SECTION 2. Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than five (\$5.00) dollars.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
