

ORDINANCE NO. 9/.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING DRUNKENNESS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, AND PRESCRIBING AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAME.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana:

SECTION I Any person who shall drink intoxicating liquors to excess, or who shall be found upon the streets or in other public places, in a condition of drunkenness or intoxication, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefor shall be punished by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding ten days for the first offense and not exceeding ninety days for each subsequent offense, or a fine of not less than ten (\$10) dollars nor more than twenty five (\$25) dollars for each offense, or both such fine and imprisonment together with costs.

Section 2. Whereas, an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the city of Polson, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
