

ORDINANCE NO 94.

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING IT TO BE NECESSARY TO BORROW MONEY WHICH, INCLUDING, THE EXISTING INDEBTEDNESS WILL BE IN EXCESS OF THREE PERCENTUM OF THE TOTAL ASSESSED VALUATION OF THE CITY, TO CONSTRUCT A SEWERAGE SYSTEM, DIRECTING THAT THE QUESTION OF BONDING THE CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A SEWERAGE SYSTEM BE SUBMITTED TO A VOTE OF THE TAX PAYERS AFFECTED THEREBY, AND PROVIDING FOR SUCH ELECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF POLSON, STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1 - That it is necessary, to construct, operate, and own a sewerage system for the City of Polson, Montana.

Section 2 - That for the purpose of constructing a sewerage system for the said city, it is deemed necessary to borrow money in excess of three percentum of the total valuation of the city.

Section 3 - That at the special election, to be called as herein provided and held in said city of Polson, Montana, on Tuesday, July 28th, 1914, the question of issuance of bonds, shall be submitted to the tax payers of said City, (which including the then existing indebtedness, will be in excess of three percentum of the assessed valuation of the city,); the votes to be cast, at the usual voting places, for elections heretofore held in said city, and which voting places for said election, will be designated and named in the notice of said election, to be hereafter given and published as provided by law, and the polls are to remain open on said day, during the entire time the polls shall remain open for any annual municipal election.

Section 4 - That the total amount of said bonds shall be the sum of Twenty Seven Thousand (\$27,000.00) Dollars, shall bear interest at the rate of six percent per annum, payable semi-annually; the term of said bonds shall be twenty years from date of issue, and said bonds shall be redeemable after ten years from the date of their issue.

Section 5 - That at such election the ballots shall contain the words,

"Bonds _____ Yes";

"Bonds _____ No ";

and in voting the voter must make a cross thus "X" opposite the answer for which he intends to vote.

Section 6 - That at such election all tax payers of said city, as tax payers are defined by Sections 468 and 469 of the Political Code, Revised Codes 1907, and only such tax payers, shall be entitled to vote on such question.

Section 7 - That the passage of this Ordinance being deemed immediately necessary for the preservation, of peace, health and safety, it is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and to be and become immediately affective from and after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 95

An Ordinance providing for the registration of the tax payers or qualified electors of the City of Polson, Montana, for the special city sewerage bond election, heretofore called and to be held on the 28th day of July, 1914, for the purpose of submitting to the said tax payers or qualified electors the question of bonding the said city of the purpose of constructing a sewerage system for the said city and THE MANNER IN WHICH SAID REGISTRATION SHALL BE NAMED.

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson, State of Montana:

Section 1 - The City Clerk is hereby appointed and made the official registrar of the City of Polson, Montana and shall keep and enter in registers to be designated as ward or precinct registers ~~###~~ the names of the qualified electors in the respective wards of said city, for said special bond election; the City Clerk shall register the names of all persons qualified for such an election at his office in The Security State Bank in said city and not elsewhere, between the hours of nine A.M. and six P.M. on all legal days, in the manner as hereafter provided, and only those persons and taxpayers or qualified electors whose names are so registered by the said city clerk as provided in this ordinance shall be entitled to vote at the ensuing special election called and holden on the 28th day of July, 1914, directing that the question of bonding the said city for the purpose of constructing a sewer system, be submitted to the vote of the tax payers of the said city, affected thereby.

Section 2 - Suitable registration books and check lists shall be provided by the City Clerk and the expense thereof, if any, charged to the said city; said books to be as near as practicable the same as used at regular or general elections in the said city.

Section - 3 - The City Clerk, as ex-officio city registrar, must enter on the precinct or ward register herein provided for, under the proper heading, the number and date of the registration, the name in full, the occupation, the age, the sex, and nativity of the elector, the length of time the elector has resided within the State of Montana, County of Flathead and City of Polson, the number of the ward of said city, within which the elector resides. If any person fails or refuses to give the answers in any particular, as may be required by question of the City Clerk, he must not be registered.
