ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY NO. 2023-04:

Private Street Signage

All traffic control devices to be installed at the intersection of Private Streets with public streets will be maintained by the City of Polson. All traffic control devices to be installed at internal intersections of two private streets shall be installed and maintained by and at the expense of the developer, property owner(s) or persons having right of access to the property. The City of Polson will not install, maintain, or repair any traffic control devices located on private property or private businesses entrance/exits.

All signs installed under this policy shall comply with the *Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*, Polson Municipal Code, and *Polson Standards for Design & Construction*.

All street names shall be done as Upper/Lower case alphabets. Directly below the street name shall be the marking "PRIVATE STREET" in all Upper Case lettering. See example below:



Likewise, each Private Street sign installed and maintained by the City of Polson shall have a second sign installed, directly below, indicating "Not City Maintained"; of the same blue/white color theme with Upper/Lower case alphabets. See Example Below:

Not City Maintained

For the purpose of this policy, the term "Private Street" means a way open to travel by the public including but not limited to roads, streets, highways, or alleys, in which the City has an interest by dedication, grant, operation of law, or otherwise, where the obligation to repair and maintain

such way has not been accepted by the City or is otherwise the responsibility of some other person or entity.
