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ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY NO. 2021 – 03: Annexation Guidance

The City of Polson will process all requests for annexation, whether citizen or self-initiated, according to the Montana Code Annotated and Polson Municipal Code. In doing so, *this* Administration will be guided by several principles, recognizing that each annexation presents unique circumstances which must be considered:

- The city should only provide water/sewer services to properties annexed within the city limits; accepting that, historically, this has not always been the case.
- As practically possible, property petitioning for annexation should be required, as a condition of annexation, to upgrade all infrastructure to city standards. Where this is not possible due to special circumstances (not just inconvenience or cost), any permitted non-standard infrastructure should be detailed in a written 'annexation agreement', and accompanying City Commission resolution, that clearly outline future maintenance, repair, and replacement responsibilities; signed by all property owners --accepted/approved by the City Commission -- recorded with County Clerk.
- All citizen-initiated requests for annexation should submit a signed 'Waiver of Special Improvement District' for all affected properties.
- Only in unusual circumstances will the Administration recommend a deannexation of property to the City Commission.
- Annexation of 'wholly surrounded' county areas, within the city limits, is a priority for the Administration.
