

ORDINANCE NO. 3.

An Ordinance to provide for the establishing of fire limits, to regulate the erection and construction of buildings, tents, and flues within the town of Polson, and to provide a penalty for the violation of the same.

Be it ordained by the Council of the town of Polson.

Section I. All that portion of the Town of Polson contained within the following boundaries, to-wit:- Beginning at a point on Meander line 188 feet North of N. W. cor. of Block I; thence running due South on 5th St. to N. W. Cor. Block I7; thence West on D. St. to N. E. corner of Block I8; thence South on 4th St. to the N. W. cor. of Block 28; thence West on F. Street to N. E. Cor. of Block 3I; thence ~~North~~ to Public Reserve; thence N. E. along the reserve line to the N. W. Cor. of Block II; thence West 282 feet to Meander line; thence N. $74^{\circ} 10'$ East 293.1 feet; thence N. 48° East 249.5 feet; thence N. $43^{\circ} 27'$ East 293.4 feet; North $21^{\circ} 34'$, East, 347.8 feet; thence N. 40° E. 250 feet; thence North $78^{\circ} 51'$ East 210.8 feet, thence South 75° East to place of beginning, shall be known as the inner fire limits.

Section 2: All that portion of the Town of Polson contained within the following boundaries, to-wit: Beginning at a point on Meander Line 188 feet North of N. W. corner of Block I; thence South 75° E. 255 feet; thence South $32^{\circ} 44'$ E, 108.2 feet; thence South 2647.4 feet to S. E. corner of the town; thence N. $89^{\circ} 37'$ W. 1984 feet to the S. W. corner ~~Town~~, thence N. 0° $17'$ E, 1539.3 feet; thence N. $21^{\circ} 16'$ E. 261.4 feet; ~~thence N. $54^{\circ} 30'$ E. 180 feet;~~ *thence East 282 feet;* thence S. $18^{\circ} 26'$ W. 316.2 feet; thence S. 45° ~~#~~. 115.1 feet; thence S. to N. E. corner Blk. 3I; thence E. to N. E. corner Blk. 28; thence N. to N. W. corner Blk. I8; thence East to N. W. corner Blk. I7; thence N. to point of beginning; shall be known as the outer fire limits.

Section 3: No tent shall be erected or maintained for a period of more than ten (10) days from passage of this Ordinance in the following blocks: 4, 5, 10, 11, 13 and 14 and any person or persons who violates this section shall on conviction be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars.


Section 4: That after the passage of this Ordinance every building erected within the limits of said town wherein fire shall be intended to be used, shall be furnished with at least one substantial brick chimney, or one of stone or other material equally as safe and

fire-proof, securely plastered throughout on the inside, and also on the outside where passing through inaccessible places or near wood work, and no person shall be allowed, in any building hereafter within the limits of said town, to run a stove pipe through the roof or side of the same nor in any place wherein such arrangement now exists within said limits shall the same be allowed to continue beyond thirty (30) days from the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Hereafter, in all buildings erected, repaired or altered within the limits of said town, when it shall be desired that stove pipes shall pass through any partition wall of wood or partly of wood, the same shall be secured by an iron or tin thimble with at least a two-inch air chamber, and where any pipe shall enter a chimney, the same shall be provided with an iron thimble securely fitted. And every stove, before used, shall be provided with zinc, iron, tin or something equivalent to protect the wood work underneath and around said stove from taking fire therefrom.

Section 6. That after the passage of this Ordinance, the Mayor is hereby authorized to notify all parties who have buildings or flues that are dangerous to the public safety to replace the same with suitable flues in accordance with this ordinance within thirty (30) days from said notice, and upon the failure to comply with same shall be subject to the fines and penalties as provided in this Ordinance. Any violation of either of the provisions of this act shall, on conviction thereof, be punished by fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars, and every day of continued violation after due notice shall be deemed a separate offense, punishable with like fine.

Section 7. Whereas an Emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation of peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Town of Polson, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
