

ORDINANCE NO 11.

An Ordinance provideing for the sale of sand and gravel, and provideing rules and regulations and penalties, covering the same.

Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Polson.


Section 1 It shall be unlawful, for any person or persons company, or corporation to take or remove from any of the shores bording upon the city of Polson, any sand or garvel with out first having paid for the same and obtained a permit as hereinafter provided.


Section 2. Any person or persons, company or corporation, desireing to purchase any sand or gravel along the shores of the city of Polson, shall be allowed to purchase the same from the city of Polson, and remove the same from the said shores upon payment to the city Treasurer of the sum of .25 cents for each and every wagon load of said sand or gravel, and said City Treasurer is hereby authorized to grant the permit for the removal of same.

Section 3. Upon the trial of any action for violation of this Ordinance the Defendant is deemed not to have paid for the said sand or gravel or procured a permit unless he either ~~proves it~~ in Court or proves that he has received authority as by this Ordinance provided.

Section 4. Any person or persons, company, or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this Ordinance and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$100.00, or may be confined in the city jail for a period of not less than one day nor more than ninty days, or by both such fine and improsonment, and shall stand ~~convicted~~ until such fine is paid or sentence fulfilled.
