

## ORDINANCE NO. 18.

An Ordinance to amend sections 2 and 3 of Ordinance No. 16 providing for the registration of Voters.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Polson.

Section 1.- That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 16 be amended to read as follows:-

There shall be appointed for the City of Polson a Board of Registration, consisting of two qualified electors of said City, not more than one of whom shall be of the same political party. The Board of Registration shall be appointed by the Mayor by and with the advice and consent of the Council, at the first meeting in May of each year, and they shall continue in office until their successors are appointed and qualified; provided however that the registration board that is to act prior to May of 1911 shall be appointed forthwith. Vacancies in said board shall be filled as soon as they are known to exist.

Section 2.- That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 16 be amended to read as follows:-

For official misconduct or other good cause, the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council, may remove any person appointed to said board. The members of said board shall each take and subscribe the oath of office as required by law for the faithful performance of their duties before some officer authorized to administer oaths, before entering upon their duties as such members of said board of registration, and file the same with the City Clerk. There shall be but one registration district for the City of Polson.

Section 3.- Whereas an emergency exists and it is immediately necessary for the preservation, peace, health and public safety to the inhabitants of the City of Polson, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.

Section 4.- Sections 2 and 3 of Ordinance No. 16 and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
