

ORDINANCE NUMBER 22.

An Ordinance regulating and fixing the salaries of the officers of the City of Polson.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson.

Section 1 - The compensation of the Mayor, Aldermen, City Clerk, City Treasurer, City Attorney, Police Judge, Health Officer, Street Commissioner, Chief of Police, Chief of Fire Department, Policemen and Firemen is hereby fixed and established at the following named salaries; that the same shall be accepted and taken as full compensation for all services to be rendered by said officers for the City of Polson for the years ending on the first Monday of May 1912 and 1913:-

Mayor, per annum -----	\$200.00
Police Judge, per annum -----	150.00
City Clerk, per annum -----	200.00
City Treasurer, per annum -----	200.00
Health Officer, per annum -----	100.00
Chief of Police and Street Commissioner, per annum -----	900.00
Chief of Fire Department, per call ---	2.00
Policemen, each, per day -----	3.00
Firemen, per call -----	1.50

Section 2 - The said several salaries shall be paid at the end of each month, by the order of the Council and the order of the Mayor.

Section 3 - This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
