

ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE SPECIFICATIONS FOR CLASS A SIDEWALKS AND CURBING AND THE SPECIFICATIONS FOR CLASS B SIDEWALKS AND CURBING AND THE PLAT OR BLUEPRINT THEREFOR, SUBMITTED BY FRANK FAUCETT, ENGINEER, 1945, AS THE OFFICIAL SPECIFICATIONS AND PLAT OR BLUEPRINT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF POLSON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA.

Section 1. That the specifications for Class A sidewalks and curbing and the specifications for Class B sidewalks and curbing and the plat and blueprint therefor, submitted by Frank Faucett, Engineer, 1945, and now on file as a part of the permanent records of the office of the City Clerk of the City of Polson, be, and the same are hereby adopted as the official specifications and plat or blueprint for the construction of sidewalks in the City of Polson.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

ORDINANCE NO. 211

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 715 AND 730 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, NO. 191, RELATING TO CITY LIQUOR AND BEER LICENSES AND FEES THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 1. That Section 715 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana No. 191, be, and the same is hereby amended, to read as follows, to-wit:

"Section 715. City license requirement and amount of license fees. That under and by virtue of the power granted to the City Councils of the cities and councils of this State, and in aid of the police power and regulations of the City of Polson, Montana, and in exercise of the authority reserved by the "Montana Beer Act", to the cities and incorporated towns of this State, it is hereby ordained that any person who desires to engage in the business of manufacturing or selling beer in said City under the provisions of said Act shall, notwithstanding the fact that the person conducting such place has obtained a license from the Montana Liquor Control Board, first apply for and obtain a license therefor from said City, as herein provided, and if such license is granted, shall pay therefor an annual license fee as follows:

Each brewer manufacturing and selling beer,
Three Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00),
Each retailer, One Hundred Forty Dollars (\$140.00),
Each wholesaler, One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00),
Each Club, Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).

All licenses issued in any year shall expire at midnight on the 30th day of the following June, provided that a transfer of any such license may be made only on application to the City Council, accompanied by satisfactory evidence of an approval of the transfer of the license issued by the Montana Liquor Control Board of the State of Montana for such business; and, provided further, that where a license hereunder is issued for a period commencing subsequent to the first

day of July, a pro-rata fee, calculated by a quarterly basis, shall be charged for the balance of such year; and provided further, that nothing herein shall be construed to entitle any licensee hereunder to any refund of any portion of any license fee in the event of his discontinuing such business, or the suspension or revocation of his license, prior to the expiration of such year."

Section 2. That Section 730 of the Revised Ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana, No.191, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 730. Same-Fee. Each licensee under the provisions of this Article shall pay an annual license fee for each license as follows:

For persons other than Fraternal Organizations, One Hundred Dollars (100.00) per annum, payable July 1st of each year;

For Fraternal Organizations, Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per annum, payable July 1st of each year:

The license fees herein provided for are exclusive of and in addition to other license fees chargeable in this City for the sale of liquor, beer and malt beverages.

All licenses issued in any year shall expire at midnight on the 30th day of the following June; provided that a transfer of any such license may be made only on application to the City Council, accompanied by satisfactory evidence of an approval of the transfer of the license issued by the Montana Liquor Control Board of the State of Montana for such business; and, provided further, that where a license hereunder is issued for a period commencing subsequent to the first day of July, a pro-rata fee, calculated by a quarterly basis, shall be charged for the balance of such year; and provided further, that nothing herein shall be construed to entitle any licensee hereunder to any refund of any portion of any license fee in the event of his discontinuing such business, or the suspension or revocation of his license, prior to the expiration of such year."

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
