

ORDINANCE NO 216

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO STARTING FIRES WITHIN THE CITY OF POLSON, PRESCRIBING RULES THEREOF AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, AND AMENDING SECTION 354 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON.

Section 1. Any person who shall start or maintain any fire upon any street, or private premises, outside of any inclosed building, for the purpose of burning rubbish, trash, paper, garbage or other matters, unless such fire is confined in a suitable metallic receptacle properly fastened and covered so that the contents cannot be blown therefrom shall be deemed guilty of committing a nuisance, and shall upon conviction be fined not to exceed one hundred dollars.

Section 2. Section 354 of the revised ordinances of the city of Polson, and all ordinances in conflict are herewith repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after its passage and approval.
