

## Ordinance No. 227

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD FOR OILING THE STREETS EMBRACED WITHIN OILING DISTRICT NO. 14-C, PAYING FOR THE SAME AND CREATING AN EMERGENCY:

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana:

Section 1. That all the streets included within oiling district No. 14-C shall be oiled during the summer season of 1949 by forces employed by the City.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all of said property, exclusive of public parks and public places, embraced within such oiling district upon an area basis.

Section 3. Whereas an emergency exists and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public that the ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## Ordinance No. 228

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A METHOD FOR SPRINKLING THE STREETS EMBRACED WITHIN OIL SPRINKLING DISTRICT NO. 14-D, PAYING FOR THE SAME AND CREATING AN EMERGENCY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Polson, Montana:

Section 1: That all the streets included within oil sprinkling district No. 14-D shall be oiled during the summer season of 1949 by forces employed by the City.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of sprinkling said streets with oil shall be assessed against all of said property, exclusive of public parks and public places, embraced within such oil sprinkling district upon an area basis.

Section 3. Whereas an emergency exists, and it is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the public that this ordinance take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## Ordinance No. 229

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING, AND DISCONTINUING THE ALLEY IN BLOCK THREE OF MICHEL ADDITION, AND CERTAIN PORTIONS OF 4TH STREET EAST AND 5TH AVENUE (EAST) IN THE CITY OF POLSON, LAKE COUNTY, MONTANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 1. It is hereby declared, as a matter of legislative determination, that School District, Number 23, has filed with the City Clerk of the City of Polson, Number 23, has filed with the City Clerk of the City of Polson a petition praying for the discontinuance of the alley in Block Three of Michel Addition, and certain portions of 4th Street East and 5th Avenue (east), as hereinafter described, in the City of Polson; that the said City Clerk has posted in three public places in the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana a notice stating when and where said Petition will be acted upon by this council,

and that said notice was so posted more than one week prior to this date; that said Petitioner is the owner of all the lots abutting on the said alley and the portions of said streets sought to be discontinued; that no person or persons have appeared in opposition to said petition; that said portions of said alley and said streets, as described in said petition, and as hereinafter set forth, may be discontinued without detriment to the public interest.

Section 2. That those parts or portions of said alley and 4th Street East and 5th Avenue (east) in the City of Polson, Lake County, Montana, described as follows, to-wit:

That certain alley running through the center of Block Three (3) of Michel Addition to the City of Polson, running from 4th Street East to 5th Street East; and that portion of 4th Street East running between 4th Avenue (east) and 6th Avenue (east); and also that portion of 5th Avenue (east) running from 4th Street East to 5th Street East,

be, and the same are hereby vacated and discontinued.

Section 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its final passage and approval.

Ordinance No. 230

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 222 OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA, RELATING TO NAMING AND RENAMING THE STREETS AND AVENUES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES, IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF Polson, Montana:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 222 of the City of Polson be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

That all streets running north and south in the City of Polson shall hereafter be designated as streets, and the present names of such streets shall be changed to and be hereafter named as follows:

Lake Street, in the Original Townsite, to be named and known as Lake Street;

Third Street, in the Original Townsite, and Central and Pend de'Oreille Heights Additions, to be named and known as Main Street;

Fourth Street to be named and known as First Street East;

Fifth Street and Lincoln Avenue to be named and known as Second Street East;

Garfield Avenue to be named and known as Third Street East;

Sixth Street and McKinley Avenue to be named and known as Fourth Street East;

1st Street and Seventh Street to be named and known as Fifth Street East;

Second Street, in Grandview and Polson Heights Additions, and Eighth Street to be named and known as Sixth Street East;

Third Street, in Grandview and Polson Heights Additions, and Ninth Street to be named and known as Seventh Street East;

Fourth Street, in Grandview and Polson Heights Additions, and Tenth Street to be named and known as Eighth Street East;

Second Street, in the Original Townsite and Pend de'Oreille Heights and Central Additions, to be named and known as First Street West;

First Street, in the Original Townsite and Lewis and Riverside Additions, to be named and known as Second Street West;

Hawthorne Avenue, in Riverside and Lewis Additions, to be named and known as Third Street West;

Maple Avenue, in Riverside and Lewis Additions, to be named and known as Fourth Street West;

Cedar Avenue, in Riverside and Lewis Additions, to be named and known as Fifth Street West;

Birch Avenue, in Riverside and Lewis Additions, to be named and known as Sixth Street West;
