

ORDINANCE No. 245

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 337 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF POLSON, NO. 191, RELATING TO ARTERIAL HIGHWAYS, FIXING THE EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POLSON, MONTANA:

Section 1. That Section 337 of the revised ordinances of the City of Polson, Montana, No. 191, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"SECTION 337. ARTERIAL HIGHWAYS. All that portion of Main Street from the South line of Second Avenue to the South line of Seventh Avenue and all that portion of Second Avenue from the East line of Main Street to the East line of Second Street East and all that portion of Seventh Street East from the South line of Fourth Avenue East to the South line of Sixteenth Avenue East are hereby designated as Arterial Highways."

Section 2. It shall be the duty of every person driving or operating a vehicle on any street or highway of the City of Polson intersecting said arterial highways to yield the right of way to vehicles on said arterial highways and to bring the vehicles so driven or operated by him or her to a full stop before entering upon or crossing any part of said arterial highways.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. The Council hereby declares that an emergency exists and, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its passage and approval.
