

## ORDINANCE NO. 480

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING A PERMIT FOR RETAIL SALE OF FIREWORKS AND FOR PUBLIC FIREWORK DISPLAYS AND ESTABLISH A FEE FOR THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Polson that all groups and/or individuals engaged in the retail sale or public display of fireworks obtain a permit at least 15 days prior to the opening of the retail outlet or public display.

All operators shall comply with all regulations set forth by the State of Montana.

The permit fee for operation of the outlet for the sale and/or display of fireworks shall be as follows:


All groups, business, and individuals, except non-profit organizations, shall pay a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

The permit for non-profit organizations to sell or display fireworks shall be issued without charge.


REPEALING CLAUSE: All ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

EMERGENCY: A public emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace and safety and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
